WHO CAN JOIN?

Apply to become a YFG scholar if you...

- ✓ ... hold a citizenship of one of the countries of the WHO European Region, or have the right to live and work in the EU.
- ✓ ... are under 35 years of age at the starting day of the conference
- ✓ ... hold a Master's degree
- ✓ ... have at least two years of fulltime work experience in the field of (public) health

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

Each year a number of YFG scholarships are awarded to promising young professionals working in the field of health. The call for applications opens in spring, and applicants are requested to take a short questionnaire including a motivation statement (the form is available on the EHFG website once the call is open), and to submit their:

- CV
- Copy of passport / ID
- Proof of proficiency in English
- Letter of support from their employer confirming the relevant work experience and allowance to participate in the entire YFG programme.
